Welcome to Ilkeston & Kimberley Sub Aqua Club (iksac). IKSAC is one of the most established Scuba diving clubs in the region, in 2013 we celebrated our 40th anniversary. We are currently affiliated to the Sub Aqua Association (SAA) which is in turn is affiliated to CMAS the world governing body of sport diving.

We offer full scuba training courses; our qualified instructors can guide you competently and safely from complete novice to SAA dive supervisor. We also run a full lecture program alongside your training so that as you gain practical experience and therefore you will also have a wide ranging theoretical knowledge.

IKSAC is an 'open club'. This means that we accept divers from all agencies, with no need to cross your qualifications over. So, if you are a diver looking for a vibrant progressive club you really have found this with us.

We pride ourselves on being the "friendly club"; new members are always warmly welcomed. In addition to our frequent diving excursions, we have a thriving social calendar, for this reason families are especially welcome and are encouraged to dive and socialise together.

Sub Aqua Association (SAA)

Our structure means that we're focussed on our clubs and members; we want to develop the best divers and trainers we possibly can so more people can see the wonders of the deep.

Our aim is to provide the right environment for members to continually develop their skills through a structured approach to diving and safety. Scuba diving is great fun; you get to witness sights that others never see, and our approach is focused.

We know it's important to be able to trust your diving association and here at the Sub-Aqua Association (SAA) we aim to provide the right environment for clubs and members to be safe and aware divers.

We provide scuba divers with a safe training and development programme which is recognised both nationally and internationally. We are the UK issuing body for CMAS (Confédération Mondiale des Activités Subaquatiques), the World Underwater Federation, which is the international umbrella organisation for diver training. CMAS accredited training means our divers can have confidence that their training qualification will be recognised worldwide.

The SAA is here for our members with the National Executive and Regional Representatives forming the National Council. This council helps set the future direction of the association and, as most members are volunteers who are keen divers, represents our member clubs and divers.

Members can currently receive training at no additional cost up to open water diver, also affordable national courses and discounts of up to 15% on Travel/World Dive insurance with Westfield Insurance Ltd, discounts on various items at Northern Diver and Morecambe Area Divers Limited offer 15% off website sales and 20% off instore check out the company's own websites for further details.

Training and Development

One of the benefits of the club system is that you will be able to progress through the training at your own pace, there is never any pressure to move on to the next stage before you are ready. This allows you to build up your confidence and skills gradually and learn thoroughly.

Each qualification level typically requires a mixture of lectures and practical skills training in the pool. There will then be a written exam and some assessment dives to test your abilities. These will be carried out by our SAA qualified Instructors. Most qualifications also require you gain real diving experience by carrying out a range of open water dives in different conditions, training days will be planned throughout the year.

To carry out any dive training with IKSAC you **will** be required to be a full member of IKSAC and the SAA.

Club lectures are currently held at The Gate Inn Awsworth on Tuesday evenings and/or Kimberley Leisure Centre on Friday Evenings.

Club membership & Socials

In addition to diving, IKSAC offers a full social calendar. These events are included as part of your membership package, details of our current membership fees can be found at www.iksac.co.uk. Full membership of the club is by application and is open to anyone over the age of 18 years, we accept under 18's and young people as part of a family membership only.

Social and diving events are posted on our Facebook page and on our website and by direct email so please check in regularly for updates.

Trained Diver and already qualified

Whether you are newly qualified or an experienced diver from BSAC, PADI, SSI or another scheme, then IKSAC has a range of fantastic facilities and a varied dive programme to cater for everyone. When transferring from another scheme you go through a short crossover session, so we can understand your skill level and help plan any further training if needed. More details about what we can offer are available on our website and Facebook with photos and reports from recent trips and events. We can also help you run expeditions or projects to dive sites that you may be interested in.

However, there is no reason for you to cross over unless you wish to progress your diving qualifications; all you will need is to provide us with a self certification medical form to state that you are fit to dive and proof of current insurance for UK and abroad if you intend to dive on our trips.

General Data Protection Regulation

How is personal information collected?

Personal information may be collected with the consent of the user by way of the IKSAC membership form, interactive submission or indirect submission via the IKSAC website.

How does Ilkeston & Kimberley Sub Aqua Club use this information?

There are various reasons why personal information is gathered electronically, which includes but is not limited to;

- Provision of electronic services (website and Social Media) that require a user's authenticity to be established.
- Provision of other services offered by Ilkeston & Kimberley Sub Aqua Club
- Participation in events offered by Ilkeston & Kimberley Sub Aqua Club

Information gathered with the explicit consent of the user will only be used for the purpose for which it was intended except in those circumstances where Ilkeston & Kimberley Sub Aqua Club must provide it to fulfil statutory obligations. Ilkeston & Kimberley Sub Aqua Club may use personal details to contact users directly for the purposes of obtaining further information needed to fulfil the original purpose.

Ilkeston & Kimberley Sub Aqua Club may use personal information to contact users by electronic or physical means including but not limited to;

SCUBA Try Dives

The first time you breathe underwater is an experience to remember – and you will be surprised by just how much fun it is.

It's easy to try scuba diving with IKSAC, throughout the year we offer Try Dive sessions for first-timers on request at our regular pool meetings on a Friday evening.

What's it all about?

A typical Try Dive session involves poolside tuition on diving techniques and equipment, followed by a scuba dive in a swimming pool with a SAA-qualified instructor to make sure you get maximum enjoyment from your first scuba dive.

A Try Dive can help you save time and money by finding out in advance if you like diving.

Before your Try Dive you will be asked to read and complete a medical form found later in the member pack.

IKSAC offer 5 try dives for a low fee of £40.00 which should be paid in advance; this then ensures your place on the try dive sessions.

After these sessions you will be asked if you wish to go further with your diving experience, and if you do wish to carry on you will need to join both IKSAC and the SAA.

Are you Fit to Dive

All new members and Try divers must complete a self certification form to state that they are fit to dive.

If you are at all unsure of any of the questions, please speak to the diving Officer or your Instructor. The medical deceleration is contained in this pack.

Although scuba diving is not a physically demanding sport a certain level of fitness is required, IKSAC requires that new members pass a fitness test before undertaking any open water dives.

Additionally, we would recommend that all new divers undertake a full sport diver medical.

Please note: You may not be able to dive if you have had, or have any of the following conditions

- ***Heart Disease***
- ***Chest or Heart Surgery***
- ***Lung Disease***
- ***Pneumothorax***
- ***Perforated ear drum***
- ***Epilepsy***

What do I need to bring with me?

You don't need much on your try dive as IKSAC provide all you SCUBA gear.

All you need is swimming shorts/bottoms, a tee shirt and a towel.

Why not give a Try Dive as a present?

Now that you have taken the plunge why not give a friend, colleague or a relative an amazing experience? A try dive scuba experience would make a great retirement present, 18th, 21st, 30th or any other birthday present or just as a great experience.

Try A Dive Decleration Form

Sub-aqua diving is a sport that requires general physical fitness and good health. Anyone with a medical history of diabetes, blackouts (epilepsy, etc.), perforated eardrums, high blood pressure or heart disease, any lung or respiratory disorder (such as Asthma), or dependence on drugs, may not be able to dive safely and so **MUST seek specialist advice before contemplating taking up this sport including a Try-A-Dive**

The "Try A Dive" is available only in a swimming pool with 1:1 Instructor/Student (on no account to be done in the open water) and on the understanding that the persons taking part:

- a) Are over 18yrs of age (or have written permission of parents or guardian)
- b) Consider themselves medically fit for diving and to the best of their knowledge do not suffer from any of the disqualifying conditions mentioned above
- c) Will, in the interest of safety, comply with all instructions given by the Dive Leaders
- d) Successfully complete a 100 meter freestyle swimming test. Physically disabled candidates with mobility limitations will be allowed to participate, at the discretion of the Club Diving Officer, providing they can demonstrate that they are water confident and can float on their back on unaided for a period of one minute (Club Diving Officers should be aware of the particular issues relating to disable divers and are advised to consult the SAA 'Diving with Disabilities' document for guidance before agreeing to such participation)
- e) This try dive does not qualify the participant to procure breathing gas, diving equipment or any other scuba diving services, nor does it allow any scuba diving without direct supervision of an Instructor

Every precaution will be taken to ensure the safety of persons taking part, but the club reserve the right to terminate instruction of any person should there be cause to doubt fitness or ability to dive. Club Diving Officer shall exercise their discretion and judgement as to whether the particular candidate is suitable for participation in the try dive session.
